## What Are We Learning?

- **Reading:** We are so Proud!, Letters- Ff-Nn, Skill(s)- Setting/Syllables/Working Together, Read: Am I?, Cat and Dog Work, Melvin
- **Sight words-** I, am
- Academic Vocabulary: Uppercase, Lowercase, Setting, Illustration, predict, invitation, retell, characters, expository text, realistic fiction
- Amazing Words: proud, preparation, cooperation, creation, float, guide
- Heggerty- Rhyming Words, Onset Fluency, Blending and Isolating Sounds of Words (phoneme awareness), Segmenting, Adding, Deleting, Substituting Words, Letter Naming, and Language Awareness
- Sonday- Phonological Awareness: Recognition of Letters and Sounds, Alphabet Song, Environmental Sounds
- **Math-** Using one-to-one correspondence to identify groups greater than, less than, and equal to. Identifying numbers 1-5 in sequence and understanding each number name is referring to one larger.
- Writing- Handwriting Without Tears, Journal Prompts, Invitations, Lists, Diagram
