Troy City Schools COVID Updates

- In compliance with the most recent CDC recommendations (8/11/22) Troy City Schools has adapted our COVID-19 protocol to reflect the new guidance.
- No mask mandate at this time. However, students, faculty and staff may wear a mask if they desire to do so.
- Students who test positive for COVID will be required to isolate at home for 5 days and may return to school on the 6th day if they are symptom free and fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication. They will be required to wear a mask for an additional 4 days while in close contact with other students/faculty/staff.
- Students who are exposed to someone who tests positive for COVID may remain in school, as long as they are asymptomatic. However, CDC strongly recommends wearing a mask for 10 days while they are in close contact with other students/faculty or staff.
- As we receive new guidance, we will amend our protocol to offer the best possible practice to keep our students, faculty and staff safe and healthy!
